ORDER

Director of Local Fund Audit vide letter read as 2nd paper above has agreed to exempt the State Military Benevolent Fund and Flag Day Fund from the liability of payment of audit charge, for the reasons stated by the Director of Sainik Welfare.

Government after having examined the matter in detail are pleased to exempt State Military Benevolent Fund and Flag Day Fund from the liability of payment of audit charges from 2008-2009 onwards, invoking Section 19 (2) of Kerala Local Fund Act, 1994
